



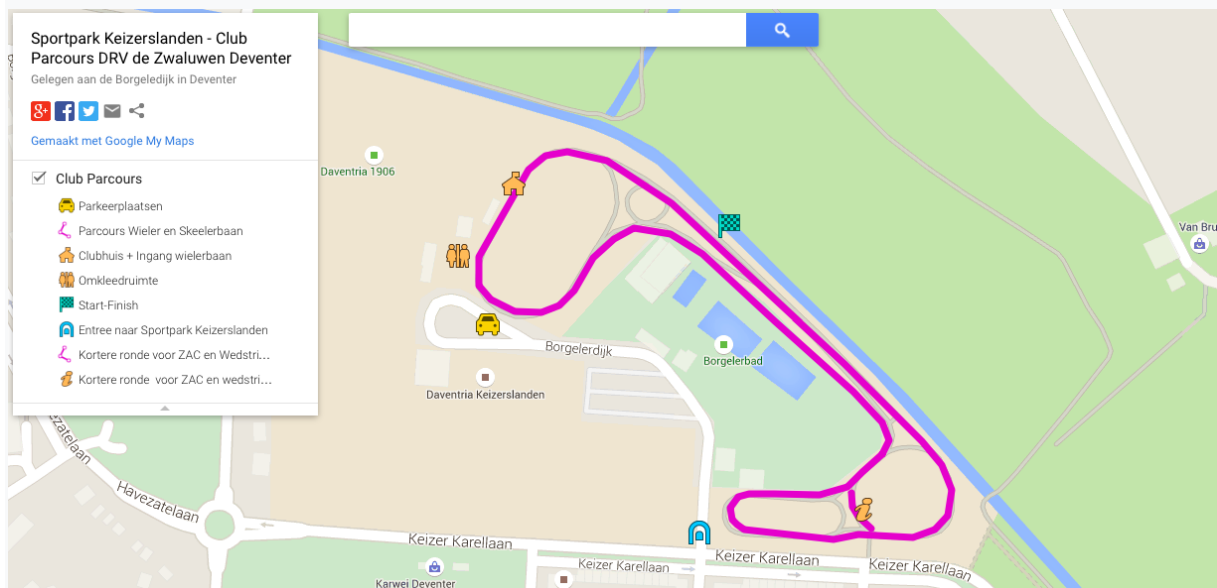

Ultrafestival Deventer

The 24 Hours of Deventer, The 12 Hours of Deventer, The Six Hours of Deventer, The Three Hours of Deventer and The Hour of Deventer

The 7th edition of the Ultrafestival Deventer will take place on Saturday 13 and Sunday 14 July 2024 at the Keizerslanden cycling track in Deventer. In addition to the main distance, The 24 Hours of Deventer, The 12 Hours of Deventer, The Six Hours of Deventer, The Three Hours of Deventer and The Hour of Deventer will also take place.

The Keizerslanden cycling track is completely flat and asphalted and has a total length of 1,289 meters. The track has been officially measured for certification, allowing national, European and world records to be recognized if run.



Parking vehicles

The municipality of Deventer does not allow the placement of vehicles such as cars and campers on or along the cycling track. These must at all times be placed in the parking spaces near the cycling track.

Participants' own service area

On parts of the course there is the opportunity for the participants to place a (small) tent and / or table (s) / chair (s) for their own care. These places are indicated by the organization and can only be taken after instructions of the organization.

Refreshment by the organization

The refreshments provided by the organization provides a rich supply of coffee, tea, broth, coca cola, water, sports drink, oranges, bananas, chocolate, yogurt, nut mix, energy bars, etc. etc.

For the participants of the 24 Hours of Deventer, pasta (macaroni) with bolognaise sauce (with minced meat) is also available. This is available from approximately 6:00 PM.

In the morning (Sunday 14 July) there are sandwiches with cheese, ham and one sweet topping available for the participants of The 24 Hours of Deventer and The 12 Hours of Deventer.

Nursing, changing tent organization

In the middle area of the skating rink, the organization has placed a number of large tents that are intended for the care, changing, etc. of the participants in the various parts. Benches have been placed in these tents for the participants to sit on.

Shower facilities

Shower facilities are available close to the track in the dressing rooms of Athletics Club Daventria 1906.

Toilet facilities

Directly alongside the course, the organization provides toilet facilities in the form of a number of Dixies. Participants and support / coaches do not have to leave the course.

Starting times of the different races

The starting times of the different races are:

1. The 24 Hours of Deventer - Saturday 13 July at 2:00 p.m.
2. The 12 Hours of Deventer - Saturday 13 July at 9:00 p.m.
3. The Six Hours of Deventer - Saturday 13 July at 2:30 p.m.
4. The Three Hours of Deventer - Sunday 14 July at 10:00 a.m.
5. The Hour of Deventer - Sunday 14 July at 11:00 a.m.

Lap registration

The lap or distance registration is provided SQM. The race number must be clearly visible at all times and may therefore **not** be worn under a shirt or jacket.

The passage with the number of laps covered is visible on a screen set up along the cycling track.

If the organization indicates that the end of a race has been reached the participants in that race will immediately remain standing. The organization then comes along with a calibrated running wheel to record the remaining distance. Only when the organization has taken up the remaining distance does a participant return to his or her service area.

Rankings

The 24 Hours of Deventer, The 12 Hours of Deventer, The Six Hours of Deventer, The Three Hours of Deventer and The Hour of Deventer have two rankings for all races for both men and women, that is 'men seniors', 'men veterans', 'women seniors' and 'women veterans'. There are trophies for the numbers 1 to 3 for each category in each race.

The 24 Hours of Deventer is also the stage for the National Championship 24 Hours this year. The National Championship 24 hours will be run in the "men" and "women" category. This means there are no age categories. The awarding ceremony will take place immediately after the end of the race.

Commemorative Medal

For every finisher in his or her discipline, a beautiful commemorative medal awaits at the finish.

Location and pick up bib numbers

The tent of the organization for collecting the race numbers is open on Saturday 13 July from 12:00. Start numbers and other things will be there for every participant.
